



MONTGOMERY COUNTY REPUBLICAN WOMEN: GENERAL MEETING, OCTOBER 30, 2025

President Barbara Eddleman called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. The prayer and pledges to the American and Texas flags were led by Kaye Stone. President Eddleman recognized the elected official, candidates, and guests. The minutes of the September 18, 2025, meeting were approved and the treasurer's report as of September 30, 2025, was also approved.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- The election of the slate of officers for 2026 was approved as presented by the nominating committee: President, Barbara Eddleman; First VP, Alice Melancon, Second VP, Nancy Hicks, Recording Secretary, Jill Stucker, Corresponding Secretary, Sabrina Amell and Treasurer, Virginia Miller.
- Membership chair Suzanne Adams encouraged members to renew their membership starting now. After the December 4 meeting, a drawing for prizes will be held of those who have paid; winner may receive a free name badge or a free lunch in 2026. Members wishing to order an MCRW badge should contact Nancy Hicks. She will place an order today. The trip to the Veterans Park has been postponed until next year due to construction delays. On November 13, 2025, MCRW will have a tour of the new Kevin Brady Library. All are invited.
- Alice Melancon reported on the fundraiser. There were 135 attendees; elected officials were supportive of the event. We budgeted to make a profit of \$25,000.00 for the event. This amount was exceeded and the total raised was \$36,242.24. Money raised will be used to support candidates. We will have two speakers from the Fisher House at our December meeting. After the meeting we will once again pack welcome packages for the families who stay at the Fisher House.
 - On January 15, 2026, MCRW will hold a Candidate's Forum for State-Wide races. Meet and greet will begin at 6:00 p.m. In February there will be a Candidate's Forum for local races at our general luncheon meeting.

NFRW Convention, Orlando, Florida, was attended by Virginia Miller. She reported on the elected officials who were in attendance and the introduction of the new slate of officers. The Ronald Reagan award was given to our TFRW president Zenia Warren. TFRW also earned several awards and MCRW earned the Diamond Achievement Award. President Eddleman reported on the TFRW Convention, San Antonio, TX. All eleven MCRW delegates attended the convention. She was proud to show the awards MCRW won: The John Tower Achievement Award, award for the most improved newsletter and the TFRW Scholarship won by member Rachael Peters. At the Memorial Breakfast our members Janie Bone, Pat Spackey and May Stephens were remembered. In 2027, the TFRW Convention will be in Galveston, TX, Moody Gardens.

SPEAKER INTRODUCTION:

Alice Melancon introduced Nick Adams, author, political commentator, and soon to be Ambassador to Malaysia. Nick spoke of how people make a country, free speech, and cancel culture. He also introduced his foundation FLAG which was designed to educate children K-12 about our government.

There was no further business, and the meeting adjourned at 1:14 p.m.


